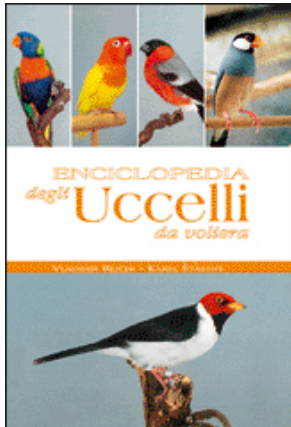

The Encyclopedia of Aviary Birds takes readers on a voyage of discovery of the immense wealth of birds to bless our world. The more than 670 bird species portrayed in this splendid illustrated book, are only a small part of the total but this carefully chosen selection gives readers a good idea about the classification of bird species and their geographical diffusion. The characteristics of each bird family is given in individual chapters along with where they are found on the various continents and seas. The particular area of each bird species is indicated by an abbreviation given after its scientific and local names so the reader is able to immediately place the bird in the photo. A description of the bird's behavior, nesting habits, wintering locations and migratory routes along with other particulars about the bird species, accompanies each photo. The Encyclopedia of Aviary Birds is a delightful read for all lovers of nature seeking to learn more about the enormous number of bird species in the world encountered at home or during travel. Magnificent photos show birds in different situations including while nesting, flying and feeding. They are portrayed in their natural habitat and close-up photos highlight their main characteristics. Some photos are about the well-known city birds, widespread throughout the world, while others show rare birds only found in specific areas which are extremely difficult to photograph.
